

TGMU: Sibling / First Cousin Admissions Policy

At The Green Acres Academy, siblings and first cousins of current students are given preference for admission. This is subject to seat availability and the candidate's merit, and it is not an automatic right.

Definition of a First Cousin: A first cousin is defined as the child of a parent's biological or legally adopted sibling, or a child who shares the same grandparents. To verify this, please provide the common grandparents' names as listed on the parents' Aadhaar or PAN card.

Any attempt to manipulate this policy with fraudulent documents will result in immediate denial of admission.

Important Admission Information

We appreciate your interest in The Green Acres Academy. Here are a few things to keep in mind as you navigate the admissions process.

Fair and Final Decisions

The decision of our Admissions Cell is final. Any attempt to pressure or influence the school's decision will result in the immediate rejection of your application. We do not accept donations of any kind. If anyone claims they can secure admission for your child in exchange for a donation, please do not trust them and inform school authorities immediately. Our process is fair and unbiased, and any attempt to manipulate it will lead to the outright denial of admission.

While we are grateful for every family that applies, we regret that due to limited seats, we cannot offer admission to every child. This is in no way a reflection of your child or family, but purely a matter of space constraints.

Mulund School Admission Process

Please read these instructions carefully, as they will save you time.

Step 1: Filling and Submitting the Form

The online application form takes about 30 minutes to complete. Please fill it out in its entirety and have all required documents ready to upload. The non-refundable registration fee of ₹1500 must be paid online to submit the form.

Step 2: Receiving an Offer Letter

• If your application is incomplete or has incorrect information, our admissions



- team will contact you for clarification.
- Once your form and documents are in order, we will send an offer letter via email and WhatsApp with a link for payment.
- Admissions are conducted in phases. Please be mindful of the specific dates and available discounts for each phase to ensure you complete your payment on time.

Step 3: Securing Admission

After receiving your offer letter, you have **48 hours** to pay the one-time admission fee to secure your child's spot. Please note that admissions are on a first-come, first-served basis within each phase, and seats are limited. Your child's admission is only confirmed after this payment has been successfully processed.
